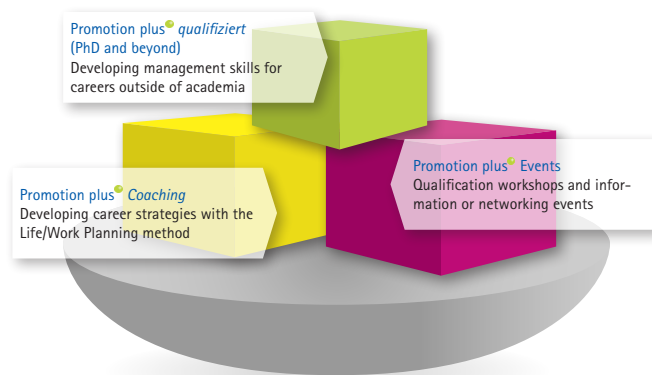


Figure: Set of Offers within Promotion plus⁺


